Summary of Guideline



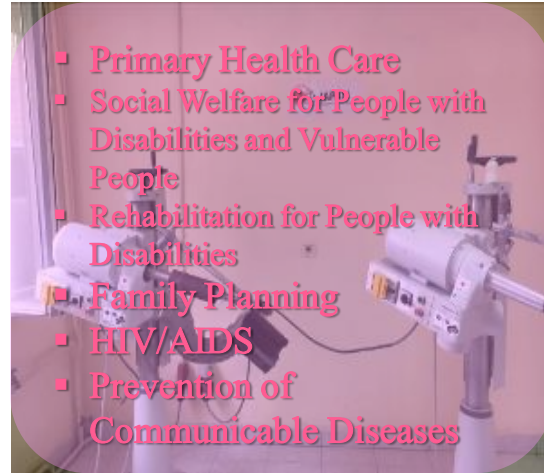
Project Areas

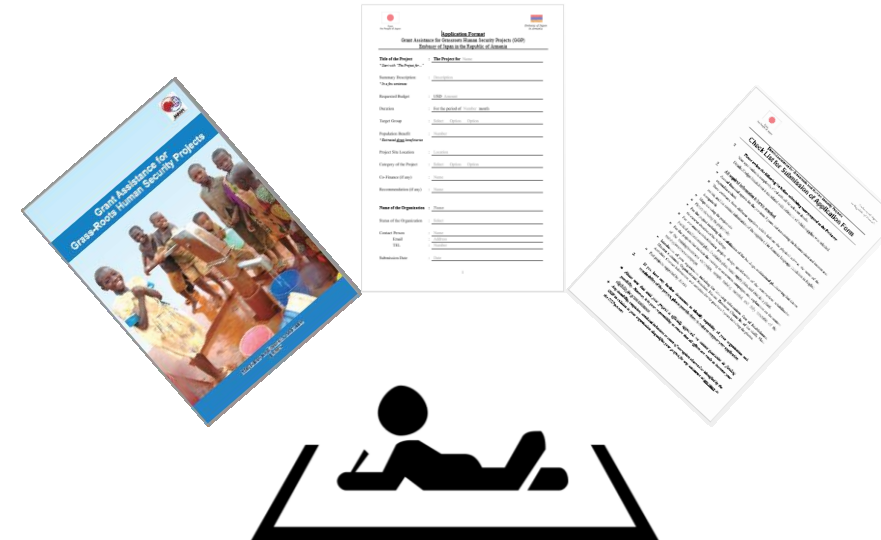

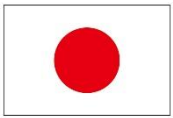
Application for FY 2017 has been closed. We are now welcome for FY 2018 which is opened until 30 June, 2018.

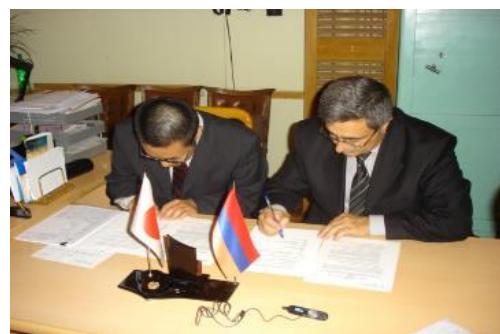

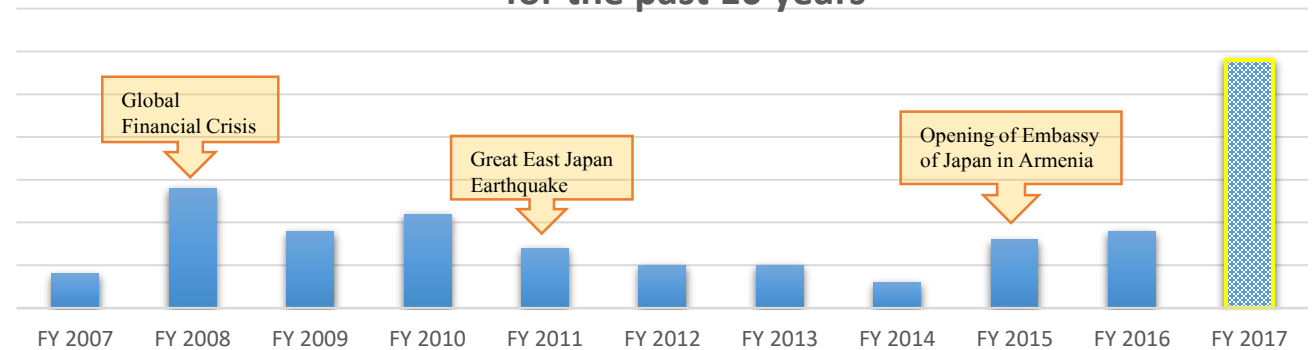
Eligible Applicants

- Stable financial status.

Sustainability and Measurable Objectives

Expand Japanese Assistance over Regions

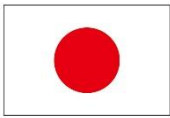
