Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects FY2017: Completion ceremony of 「Children playground equipment development plan in Armenia」 in Kotayk region

On August 8, 2018, a Completion Ceremony of "Children playground equipment development plan in Armenia" under the framework of Grassroots Human Security Grant Aid was held in Bjni Village, Kotayk. The ceremony was attended by Mr. Jun Yamada (Ambassador of Japan to Armenia), as well as representatives of "Improve our village" NGO Ms. Tovmasyan, representative of "Civil society for human rights" NGO Mr. Shahgeldyan, governor of Kotayk Mr. Petrosyan, head of Charentsavan community Mr. Hakob Shahgaldyan, and other guests including large number of children and their parents and others.

This program aims to improve the living environment and educational environment of about 3,230 children by developing playgrounds in four public kindergartens in the region of Kotayk and the public park in the city of Stepanavan, Lori region. The Grant Contract (G/C) was signed between the Embassy of Japan and and the donor group on March 7, 2018, by which the Japanese government provided US \$ 44,768 (please see here for the signature ceremony).
