
"The Project for Provision of Garbage containers for separation in Sisian city"

On March 27st, 2019, a Signing Ceremony of "The Project for Provision of Garbage containers for separation in Sisian city" in the amount of USD 19,914 (JPY 2,230,368) within the framework of Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects was held at the Ministry of Territorial Administration and Development. The Grant Contract was signed by Mr. Jun Yamada, Ambassador of Japan to Armenia and Ms. Nune Ghazakhetsyan, Executive Director of the Urban Foundation of Sustainable Development (UFSD). The ceremony took place in the presence of Mr. Vache Terteryan, the First Deputy Minister of Territorial Administration and Development and Mr. Hunan Poghosyan, the Governor of Syunik Region.

The project aims to provide 65 garbage bins for the mixed waste in Sisian city enabling the efficient and effective separation of the garbage into the plastic and other waste. It is expected to improve the capacity of the waste management and recycling of the city where 16,000 citizens reside. As a result, it is also expected that the social issues related to the garbage and waste disposal problems in Southern-east region of Armenia will be improved and natural preservation activities through the separation and recycling of the garbage will be promoted.
