

Digital publication of the Armenian female traveler's book about journey to Japan

On May 16, Ambassador Yamada visited the American University of Armenia (AUA) to commemorate the digital publication of Ms. Heggine Meliq-Haykazyan's book "A Stroll in Japan" (published in 1905) at AUA's digital library.

The year of the publication of the book, 1905, shows that the first relations between Japan and modern Armenia began even earlier than it was supposed. This fact can be considered as an important discovery in the history of relations between two countries.
