On December 22, 2021, the Signing Ceremony of the Grant Contract of the Government of Japan for “The Project for Renovation of Drinking Water Supply System and Public School in Gargar Village” up to USD 96,957, within the framework of Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects was held at the Ministry of Education, Science, Culture and Sports of the Republic of Armenia. The Grant Contract was signed by Mr. FUKUSHIMA Masanori, Ambassador of Japan to Armenia and Ms. Nune Ghazakhetsyan, Executive Director of The Urban Foundation for Sustainable Development. The Ceremony was also attended by Ms. Zhanna Andreasyan, Deputy Minister of Education, Science, Culture and Sports and Mr. Aram Grigoryan, Head of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports of Lori Regional Office.

The Project aims to improve the educational environment for students learning in the public school in Gargar Village through the renovation. Moreover, the Project will further contribute to the quality of life of villagers by rehabilitating the water supply system and supplying safe drinking water to public facilities including the school. As a result of the project, 170 students of the school and 1,492 villagers will benefit.
