

# Grant Assistance For Grassroots Human Security Projects

The Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Project (GGP) is a framework that essentially supports NGOs and local public institutions in order to respond to various development needs in a prompt and precise manner, but on a comparatively small scale. The GGP primarily targets projects contributing to improve Basic Human Needs at the community level, building on the concept of "Human Security".

## <Eligible Recipients>

- Local/International NGOs
- Local Municipalities
- Public Institutions (schools, clinics/hospitals)
- ✓ **Individuals and private companies are not eligible**

## <Project area>

- Education
- Health
- Welfare
- Environment
- Agriculture
- WASH and others

## Grant Amount

Up to **JPY 10 million**  
(approximately USD 92,500 in FY 2022)

## Duration of Project

Up to **12 months**

## Application Procedure for FY 2022

The following documents are required

**Concept Note** (All information should be provided in English)

**Photos of the Project Site** (Up to 8)

Step 1: Submit the Concept Note and Photos.

Step 2: Receive a confirmation of receipt from the Embassy.

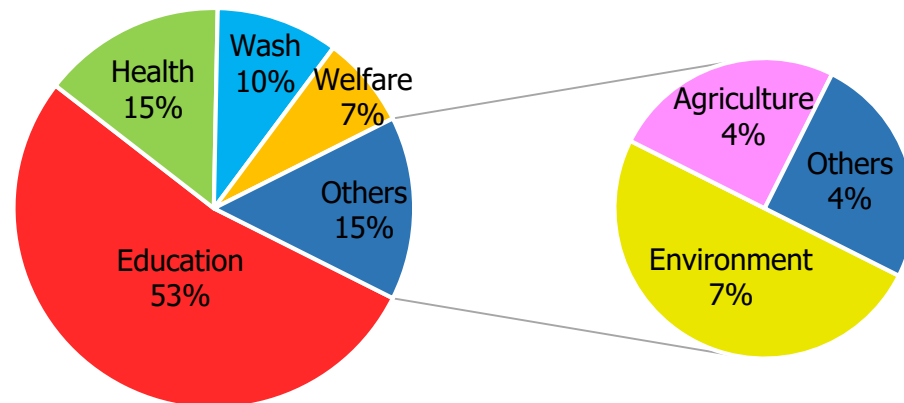
Step 3: Develop and submit the full package of application, following the notification of short-listed applicants from the Embassy.

**Deadline:** 15 th May (1 st Call), 31 st July (2 nd Call)
