

**Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects FY 2021:  
Completion Ceremony of  
“The Project for Medical Support and First Aid Training for Demining Activities”**

On June 17, 2022 the Completion Ceremony of the Grant Contract for “The Project for Medical Support and First Aid Training for Demining Activities” up to USD 77,685 within the framework of Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects of the Government of Japan was held in Yerevan. The Ceremony was attended by Mr. FUKUSHIMA Masanori, Ambassador of Japan to Armenia, Mr. Ara Nazaryan, Deputy Minister of Emergency Situations of the RA and Ms. Knarik Davtyan, Director of Foundation of Demining and Demolition NGO as well as various stakeholders including from ministries and partner NGOs/corporations.

The Project aimed to bring humanitarian demining process to the higher safety and decrease the probability of accidents or accident caused damage, as well as increase regularity and level of medical assistance received by the mine. Within the frames of the project more than 30,000 beneficiaries from Tavush, Gegharqunik, Vayots Dzor and Sunik regions could increase the level of Mine Hazardous First Aid Actions awareness.
