On June 15, 2022 the Completion Ceremony of the Grant Contract for “The Project for Establishing Community Center for Women and Youth in Noyemberyan” up to USD 70,955, within the framework of Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects of the Government of Japan was held at the "Paponts House" Social Center of the Tavush Diocese of the Armenian Apostolic Church. The Ceremony was attended by Mr. FUKUSHIMA Masanori, Ambassador of Japan to Armenia, His Grace Bishop Mr. Bagrat Galstanyan, the Primate of the Tavush Diocese and Mr. Arsen Aghababyan, the head of Noyemberyan community, as well as various stakeholders including partner NGOs, municipalities and parents/students.

The Project aimed to construct a new community center in Noyemberyan which serves as a social-educational platform for more than 250 children, youth and women to receive educational support, social services and vocational trainings.
