On January 19, 2023, the Completion Ceremony of the Grant Contracts for “The Project for Improving Sanitary Conditions at Public School in Mets Parni village” up to USD 68,059 within the framework of the Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects of the Government of Japan was held in Mets Parni Village, Lori region.

The Ceremony was attended by Mr. FUKUSHIMA Masanori, Ambassador of Japan to Armenia, Mr. Gor Asryan, Deputy Governor of Lori region, Mr. Kajair Nikoghosyan, Mayor of Spitak Community, Mr. Hrach Piloyan, Director of the school, and Ms. Arevik Hovsepyan, President of “Country Water Partnership Scientific Ecological (CWP)” NGO, as well as municipal officials and teachers/staffs of the school.

The Project aims to improve the school’s hygienic environment and further contribute to the improvement of educational environment in Lori region through renovation of existing toilets and installation of water supply and sewage facilities at the Public School in Mets Parni Village. As a result, a total of 240 people including students, teachers and staffs benefit from the Project.
