

Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects FY 2023:
Signing Ceremony for
“The Project for the Provision of an Ambulance to Shikahogh and Neighboring Villages”

On March 6, 2024, the Signing Ceremony of the Grant Contract (up to 67,498 USD) for “The Project for the Provision of an Ambulance to Shikahogh and Neighboring Villages” within the framework of Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP) FY 2023, was held at Governor's Office of Syunik.

The Grant Contract was signed between Mr. AOKI Yutaka, Ambassador of Japan to Armenia and Ms. Ruzanna Qaramyan, President of "Eco-community" NGO. The Ceremony was also attended by Ms. Nare Ghazaryan, Deputy Governor of Syunik as well as stakeholders of this projects.

This project aims to provide safe transportation for villagers living in Shikahogh and neighborhood villages to the Kapan Medical Center by equipping an ambulance at Shikahogh Clinic, thereby improving the quality of emergency medical services. As a result of the project, the transport time will be reduced from up to 4 hours to 2 hours, and first aid can be provided during the transport, providing quick and necessary access to emergency medical care.
