On March 7, 2024, the Signing Ceremony of the Grant Contract (up to 63,313 USD) for “The Project for Improving Access to the Welfare Facility for Disabled Children in Gegharkunik Region” within the framework of Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP) FY 2023, was held at a welfare facility in Gegharkunik Region.

The Grant Contract was signed between Mr. AOKI Yutaka, Ambassador of Japan to Armenia and Ms. Ms. Melanyan Yepremyan, President of Astghavard Parents of Disabled Children NGO. The Ceremony was also attended by Mr. Aharon Khachatryan, the Head of Vardenis community as well as representatives of the local government and children who go to the facility and their parents.

This project aims to ensure access to appropriate rehabilitation and psychological therapy for disabled and vulnerable children, thereby contributing to their healthy growth and psychosocial development by equipping two vehicles at the welfare center which is run by the NGO. As a result, a total of 135 children including displaced children from Nagorno-Karabakh will benefit from the project.
