
Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects FY 2024: Completion Ceremony for the Project for the Improvement of Gynecological Medical Equipment at Erebuni Medical Center in Yerevan

Yerevan: February 9th, 2026

On February 9th, the Completion Ceremony for the Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Project "the Project for the Improvement of Gynecological Medical Equipment at Erebuni Medical Center in Yerevan" (grant up to: USD 68,003) was held at Erebuni Medical Center in Yerevan. The ceremony was attended by Mr. AOKI Yutaka, Ambassador of Japan to Armenia, and Dr. Mikayel Manukyan, Executive Director of Erebuni Medical Center, along with medical staff from the center.

This project aims to enhance the center's gynecological tumor diagnostic and treatment capabilities by providing one new Japanese OLYMPUS gynecological diagnostic and treatment device. As a result of this, approximately 2,400 patients annually (including about 2,000 displaced persons from Nagorno-Karabakh) will have access to advanced gynecological tumor diagnostic and treatment services free of charge. The center's gynecological diagnostic and treatment devices were purchased second-hand and have been in use for over 15 years, with frequent malfunctions hampering medical services. Therefore, this project addresses the urgent need for a new equipment.

Dr. Manukyan, Executive Director of Erebuni Medical Center, expressed his gratitude, stating, "This excellent Japanese diagnostic equipment will enable us to save many patients by understanding the situations of tumors. With the goodwill of the Japanese people in our hearts, we will continue to dedicate ourselves to gynecological healthcare." Ambassador Aoki also delivered congratulatory speech, saying, "I hope that the equipment provided through this project will help diagnose, promptly treat, and lessen the number of women suffering from tumors, and that it will come to be widely recognized as a symbol of medical cooperation between Japan and Armenia."
