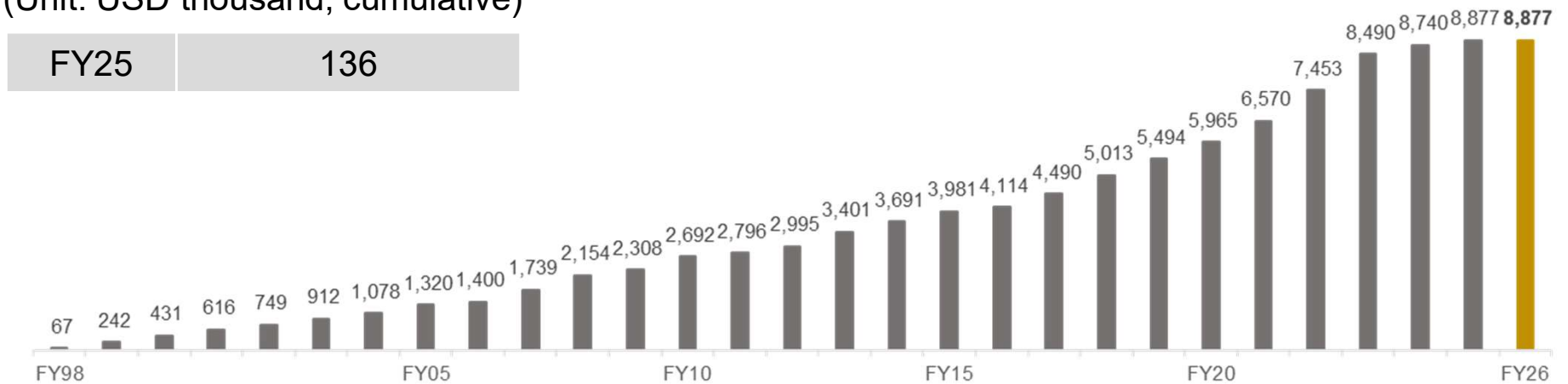
Grant and Beneficiaries

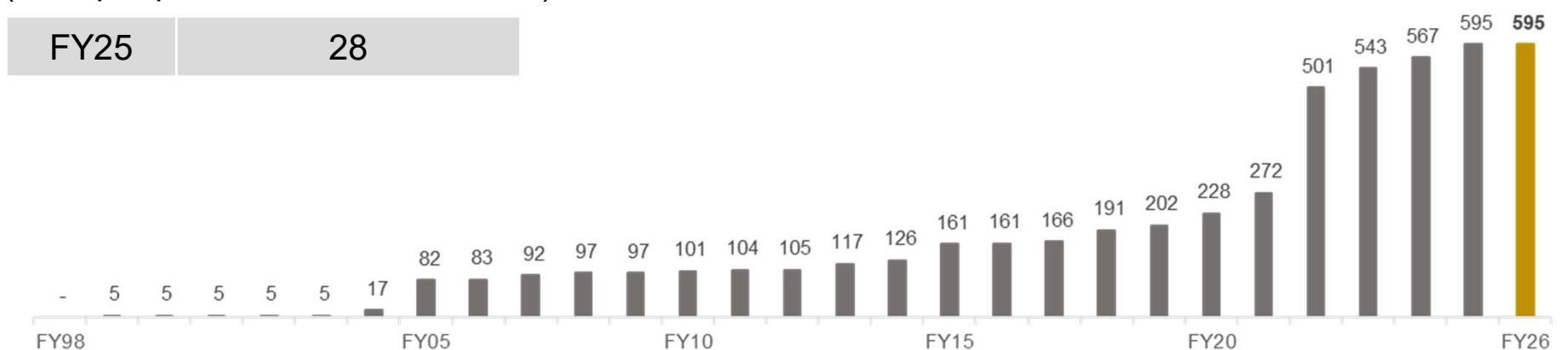

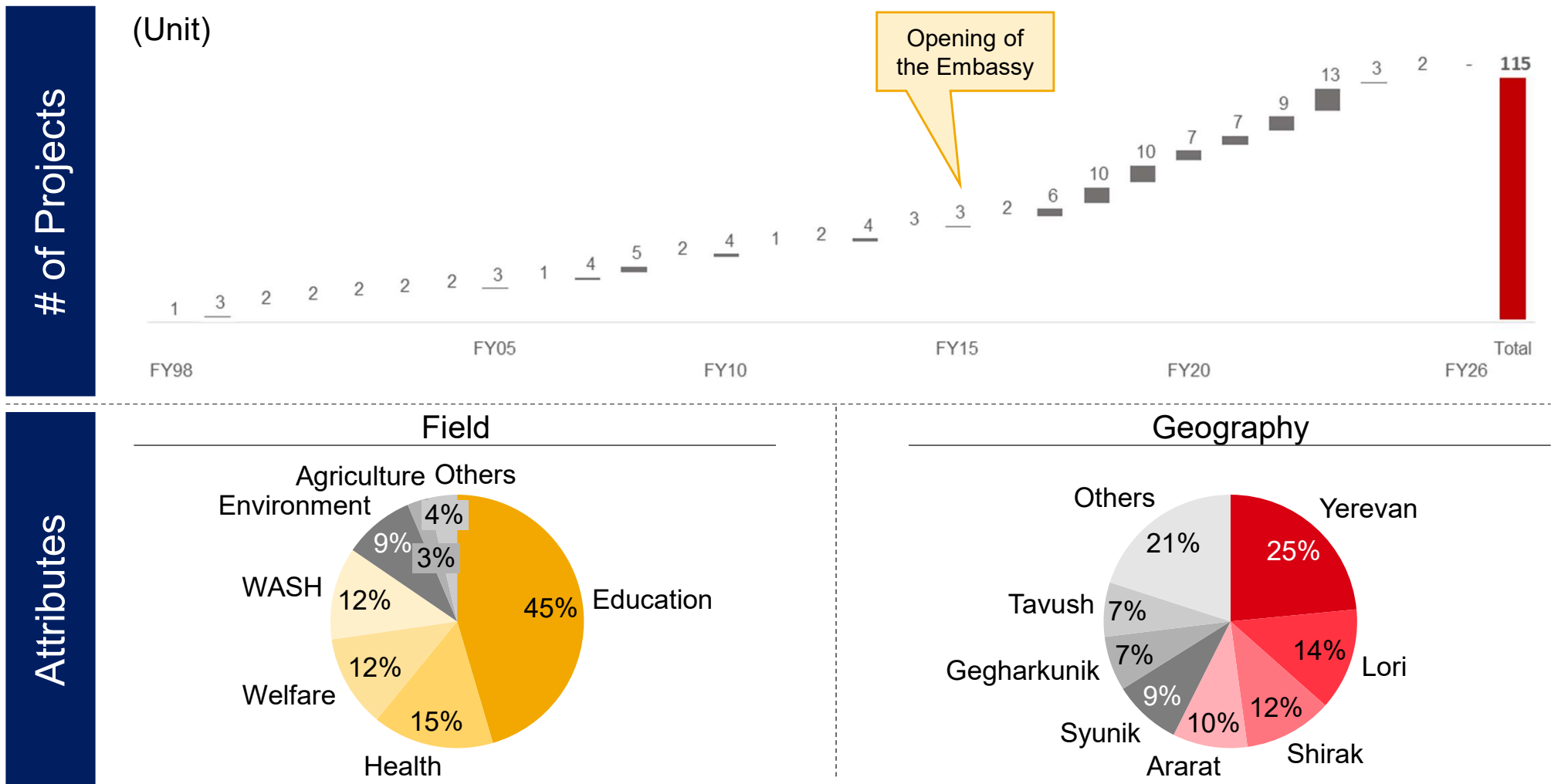

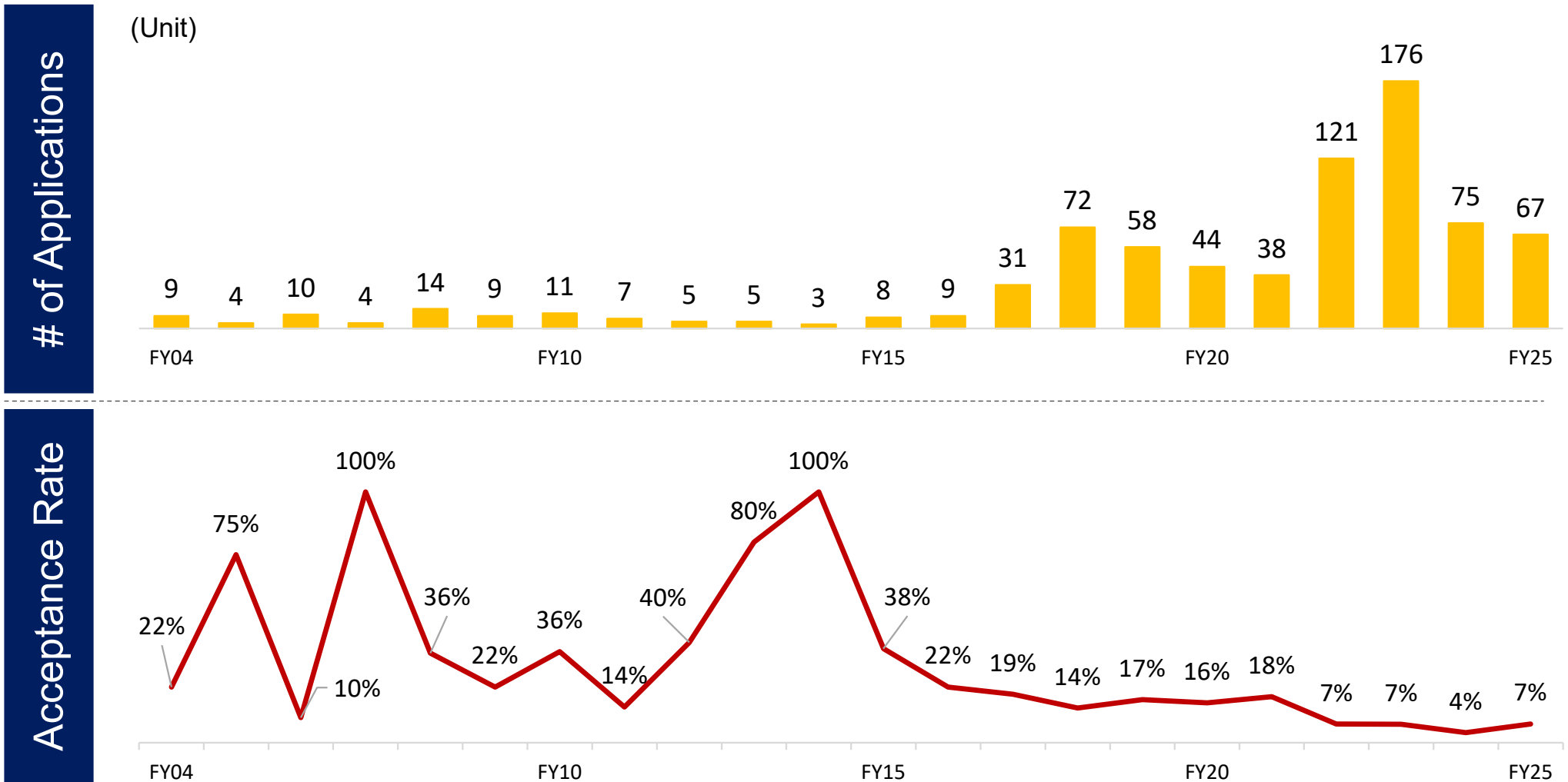

Concept of Basic Human Needs (BHN)



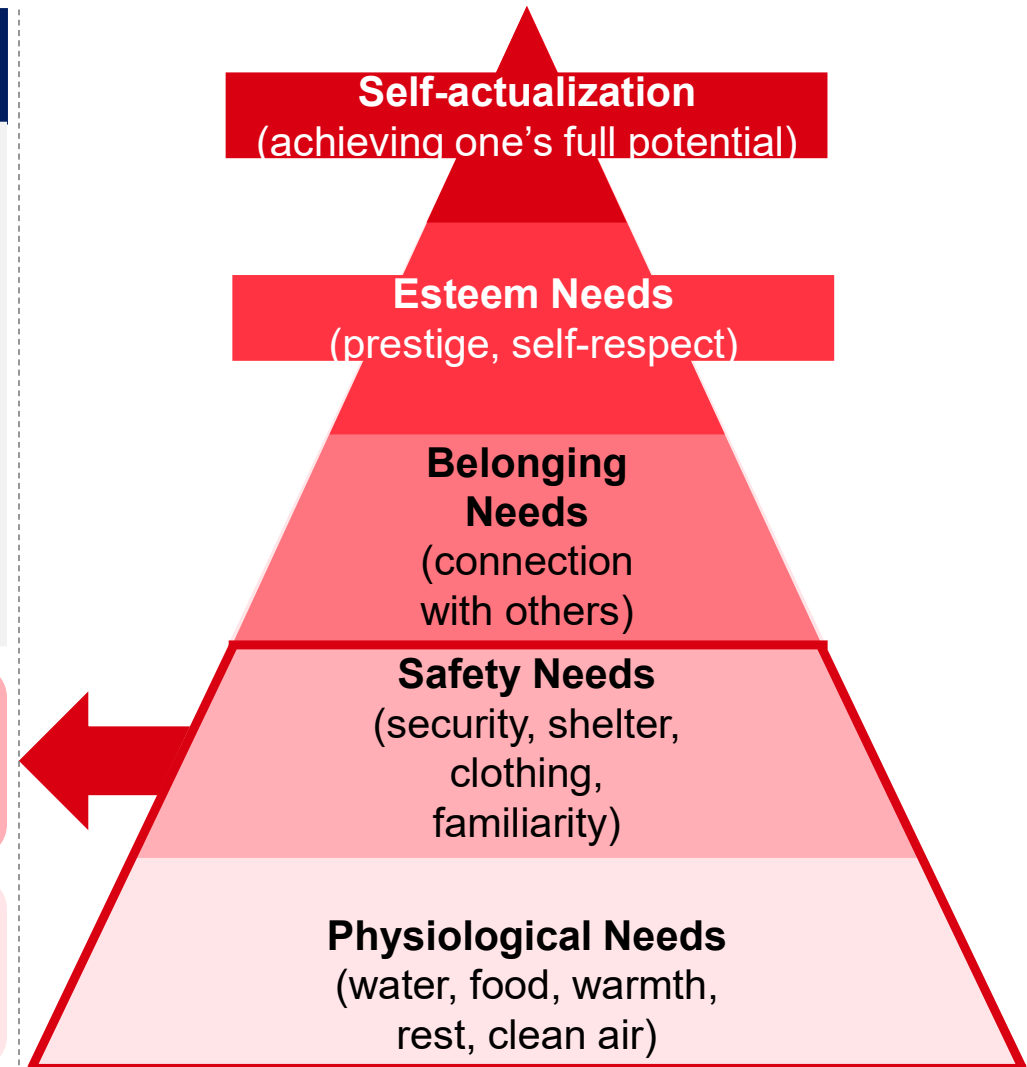
GGP supports basic human survival and safety needs to enhance community security.

Basic Human Needs (BHN)

- GGP prioritizes initiatives that address the fundamental **physiological and safety needs**, aiming to create sustainable improvements in human security at the community level

Safety Needs: Basic requirements for security: shelter, essential clothing, and stable living conditions. Critical for maintaining physical and psychological well-being.

Physiological Needs: Essential requirements for survival: food, water, and basic nutrition. These fundamental needs remain unmet for many globally.

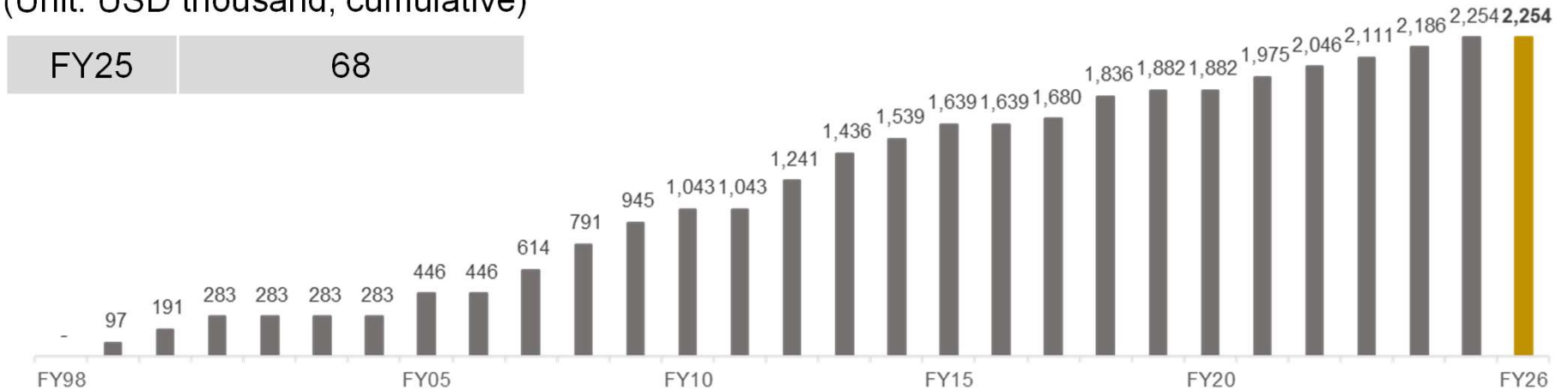

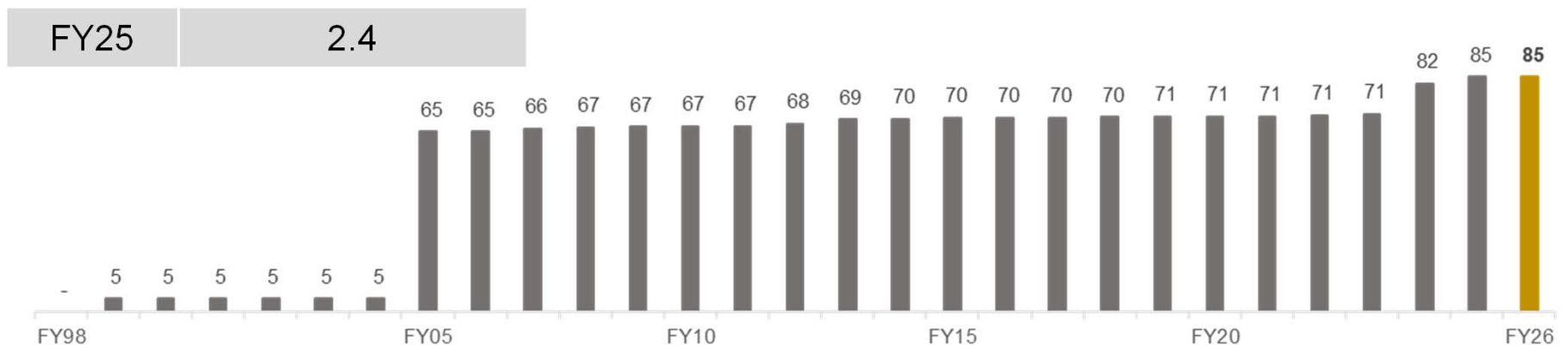

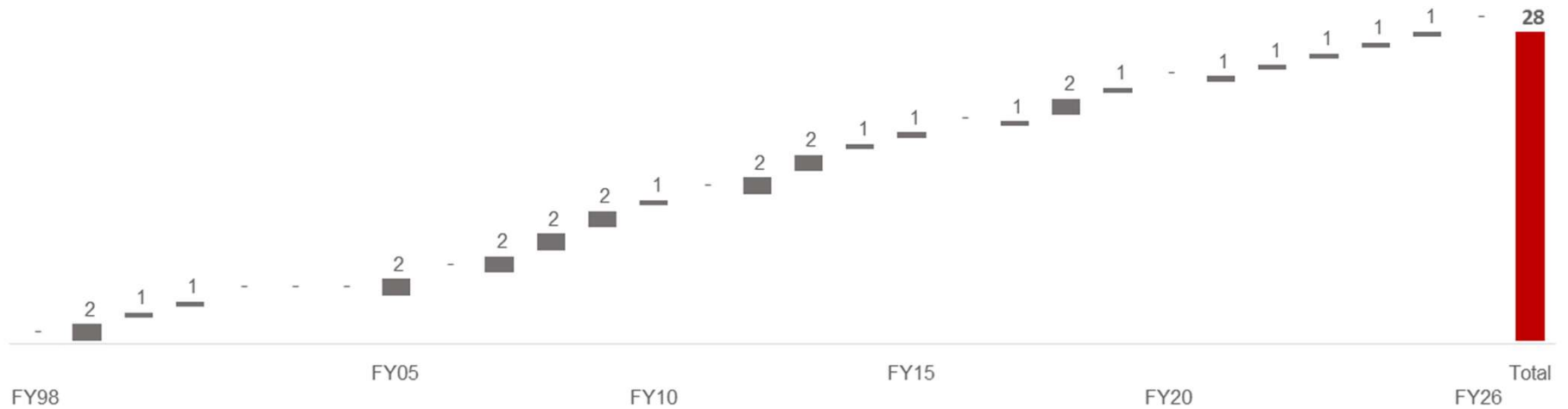

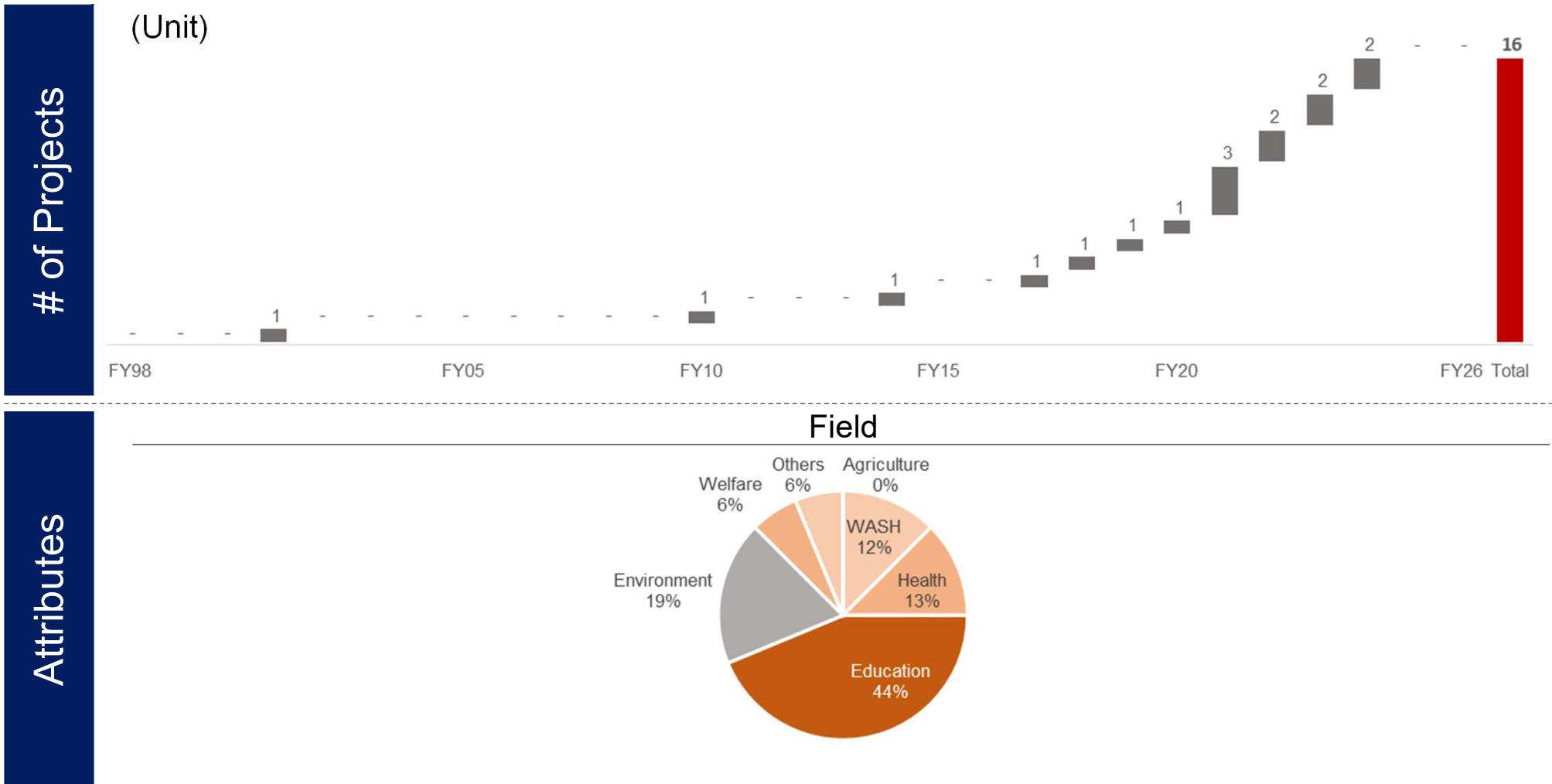

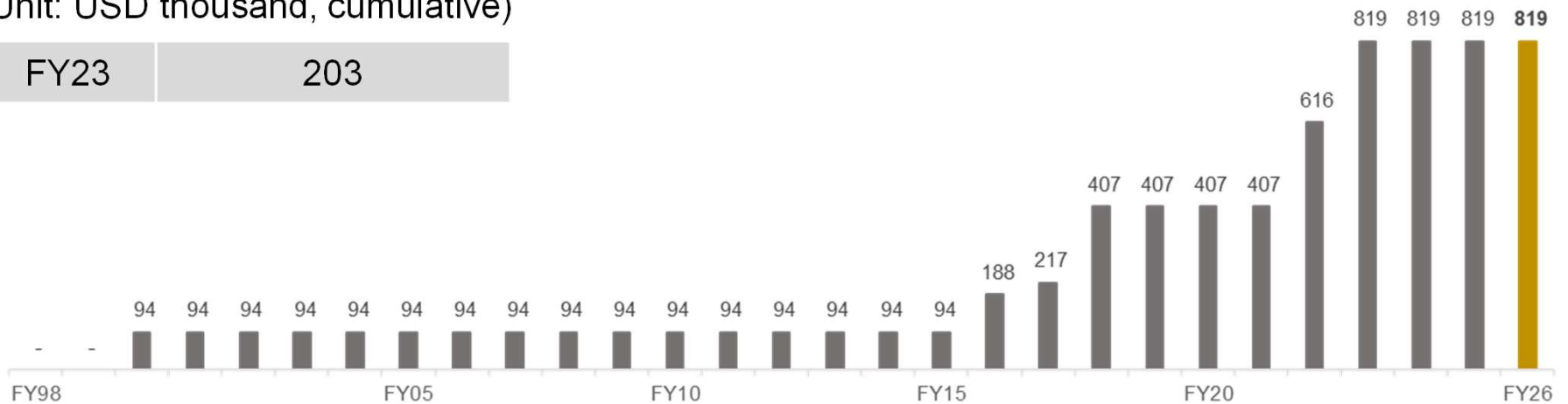

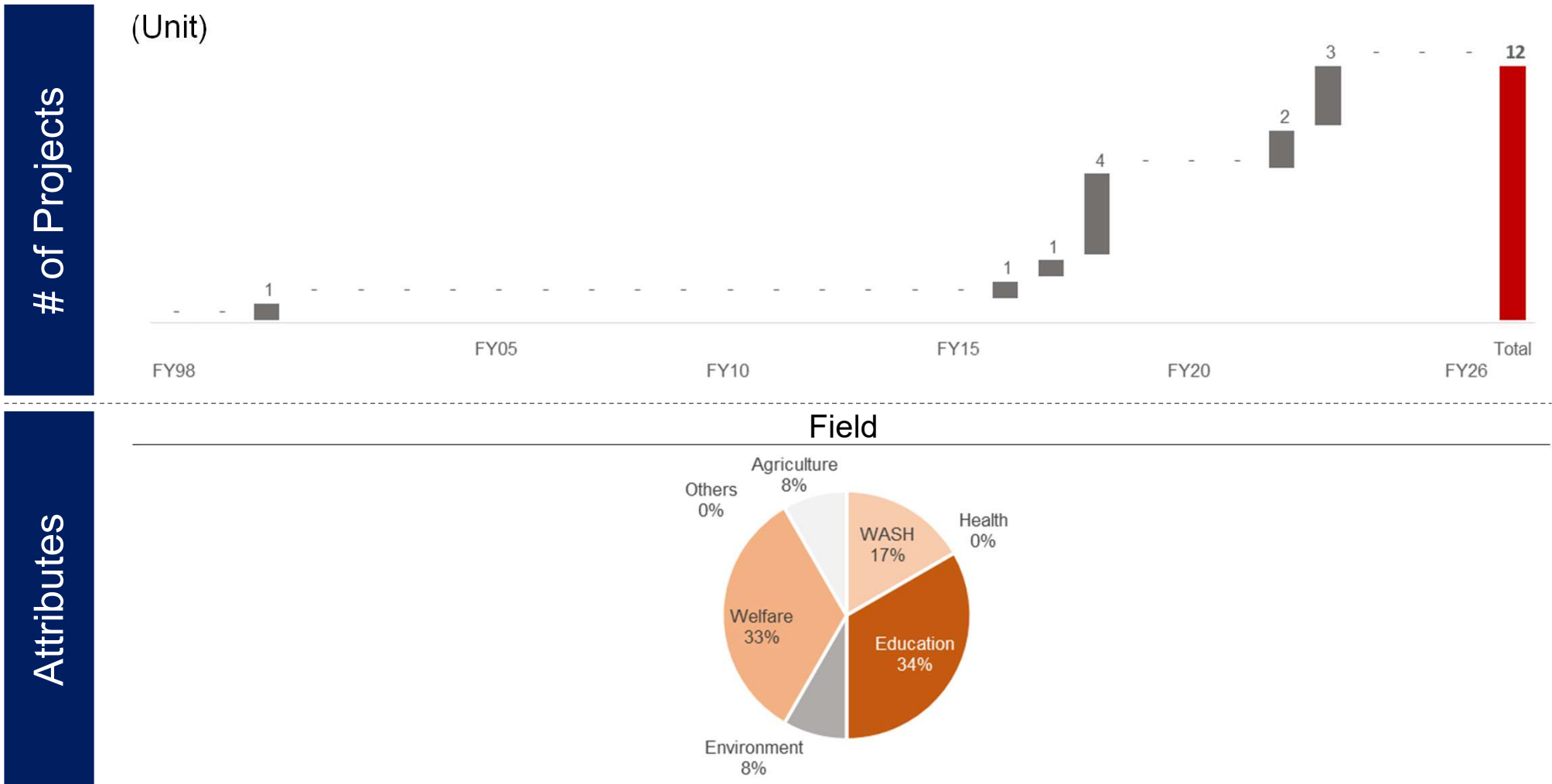

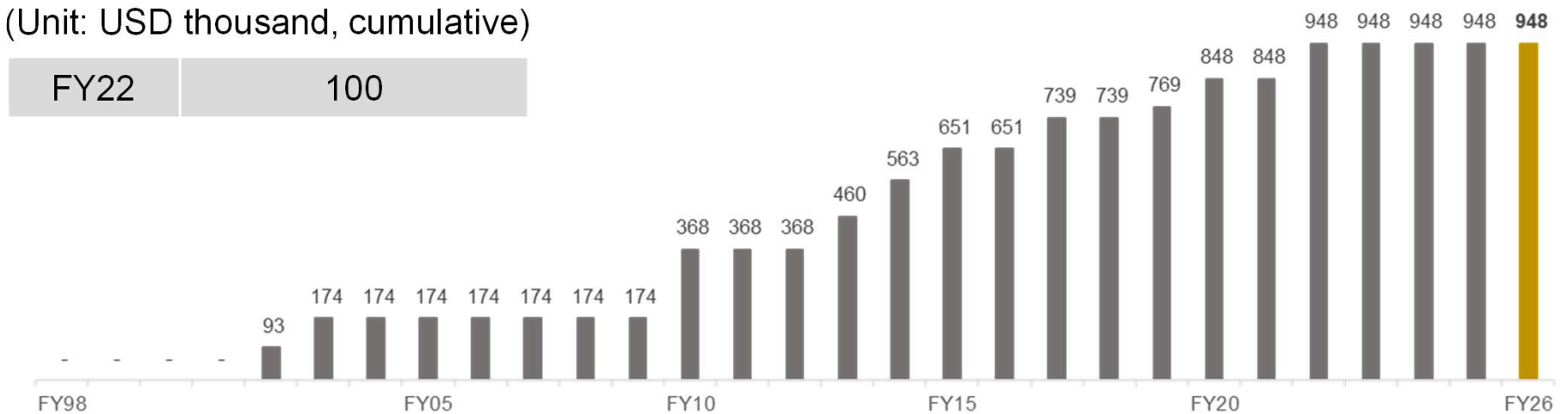

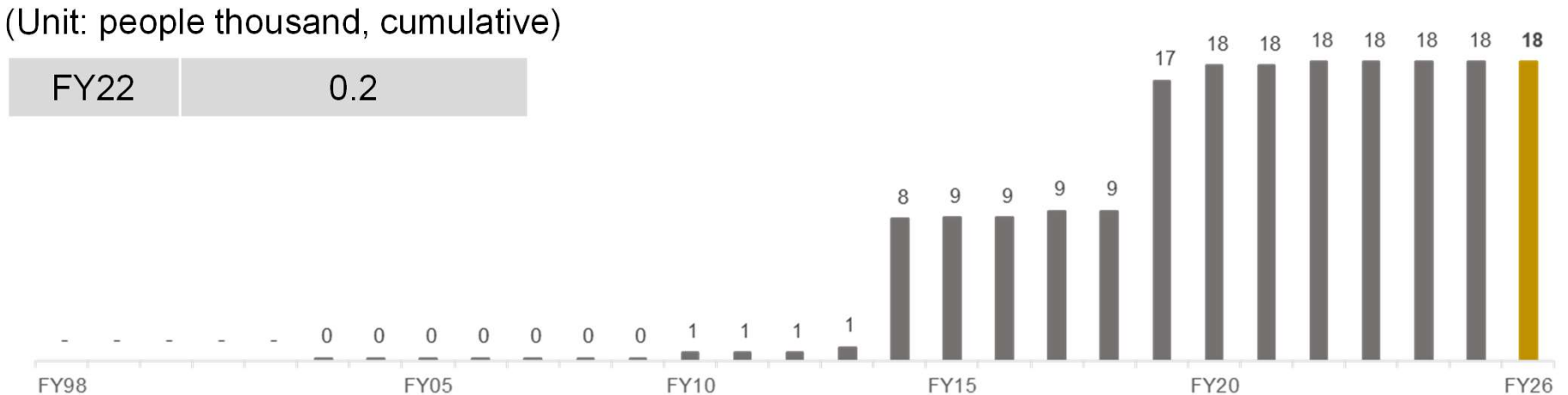

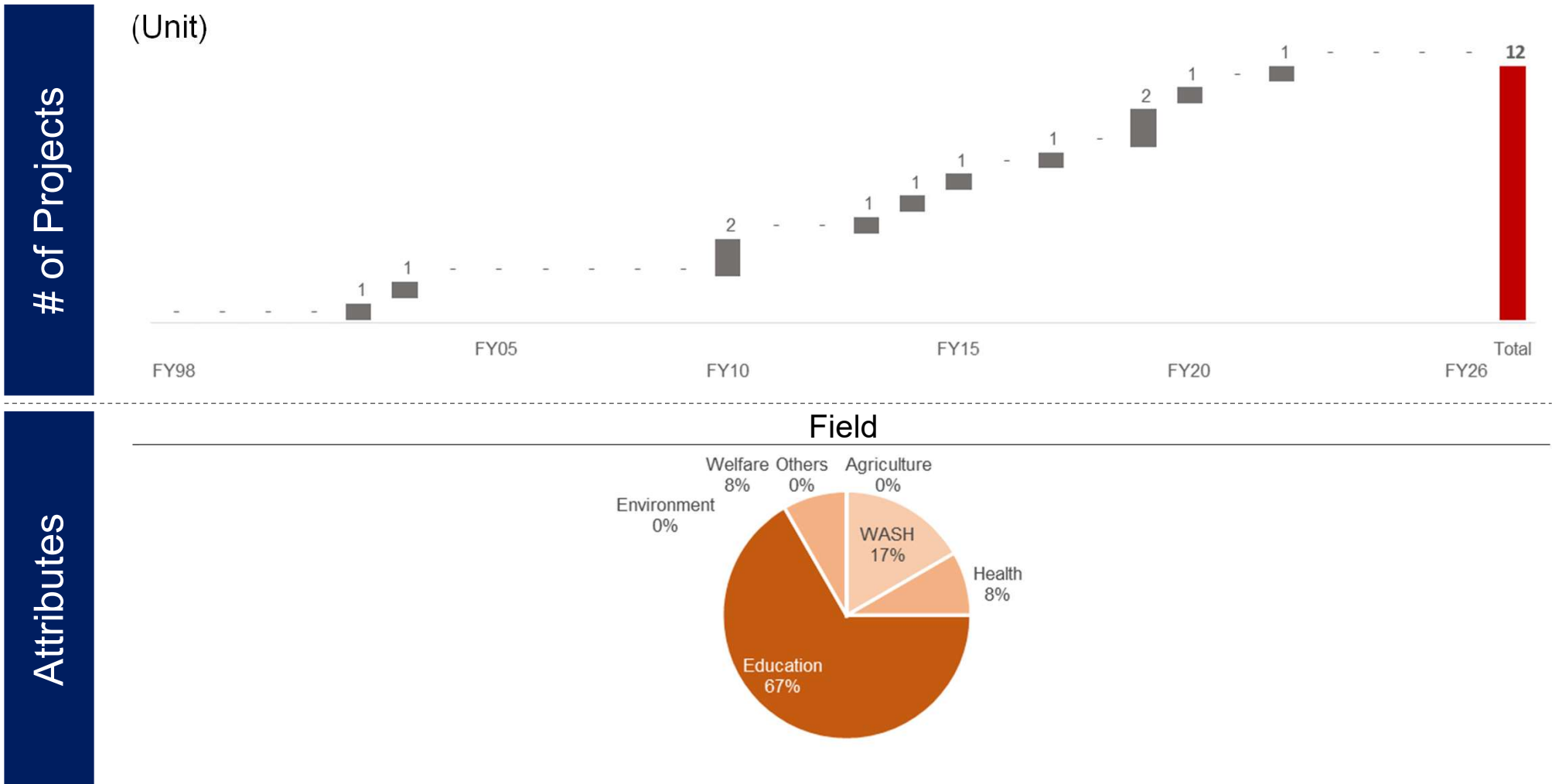

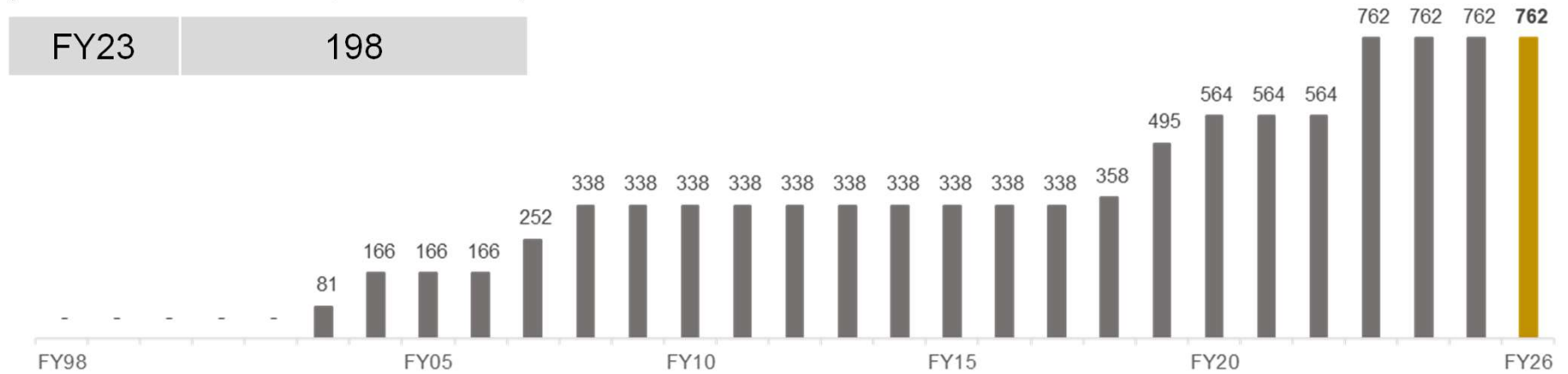

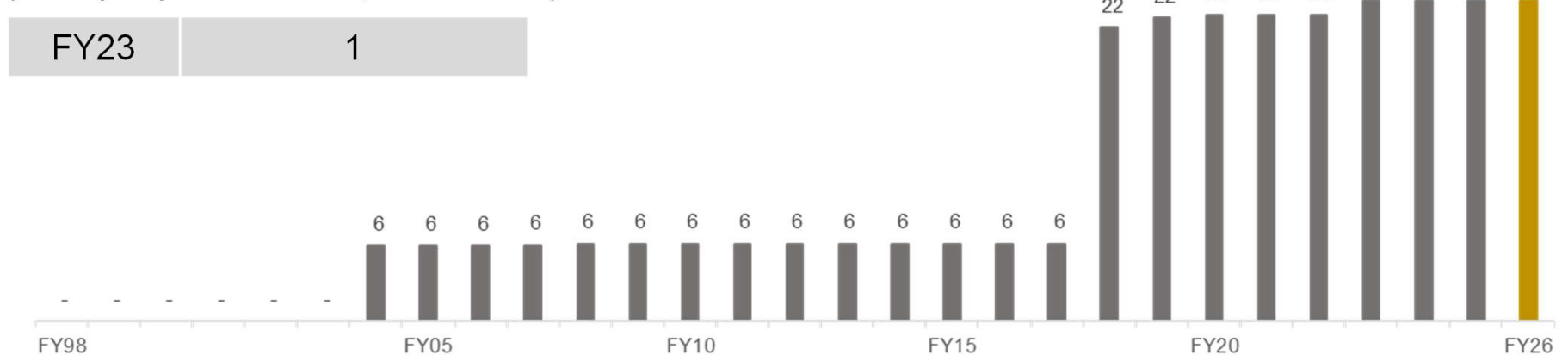

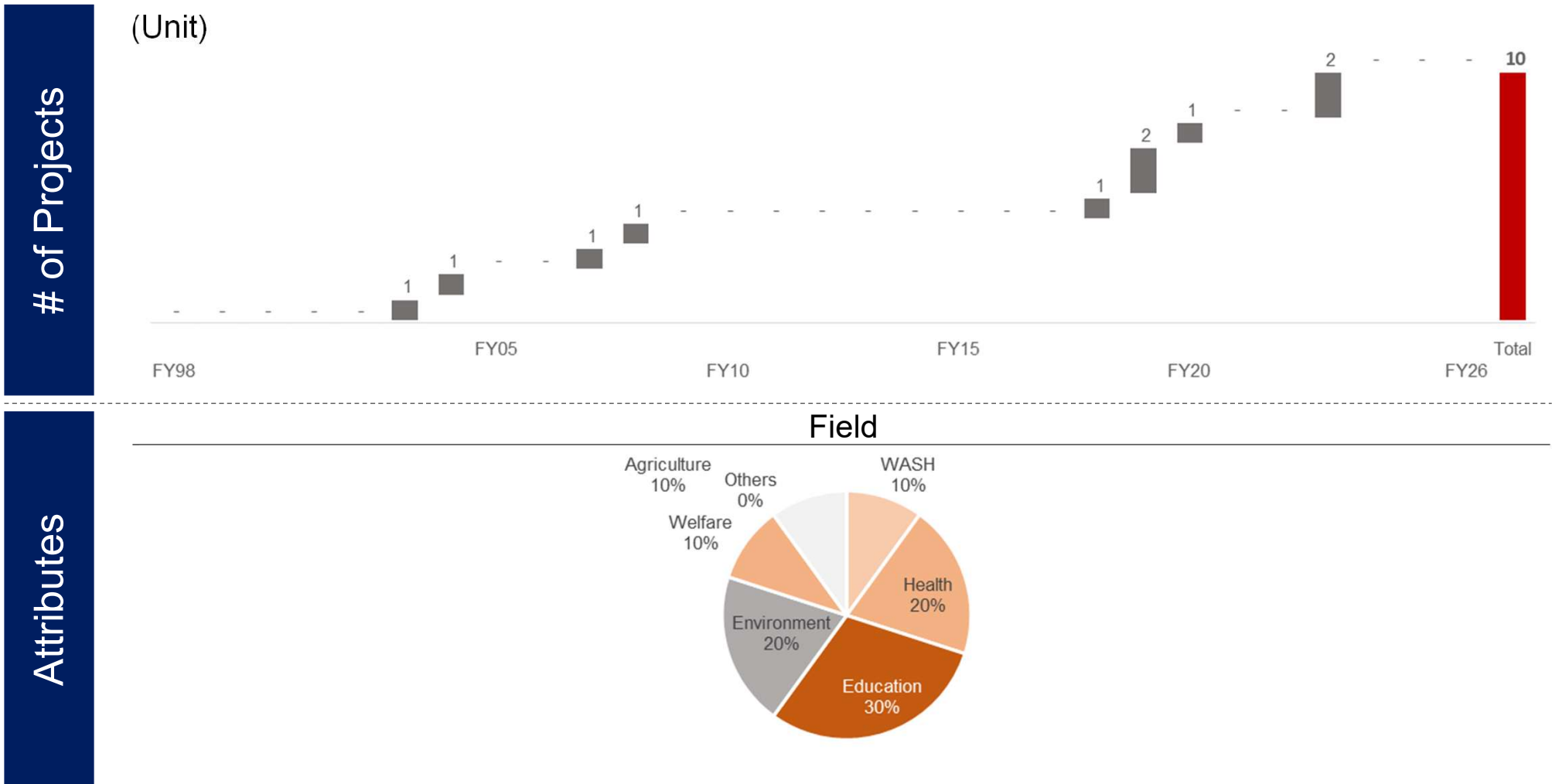

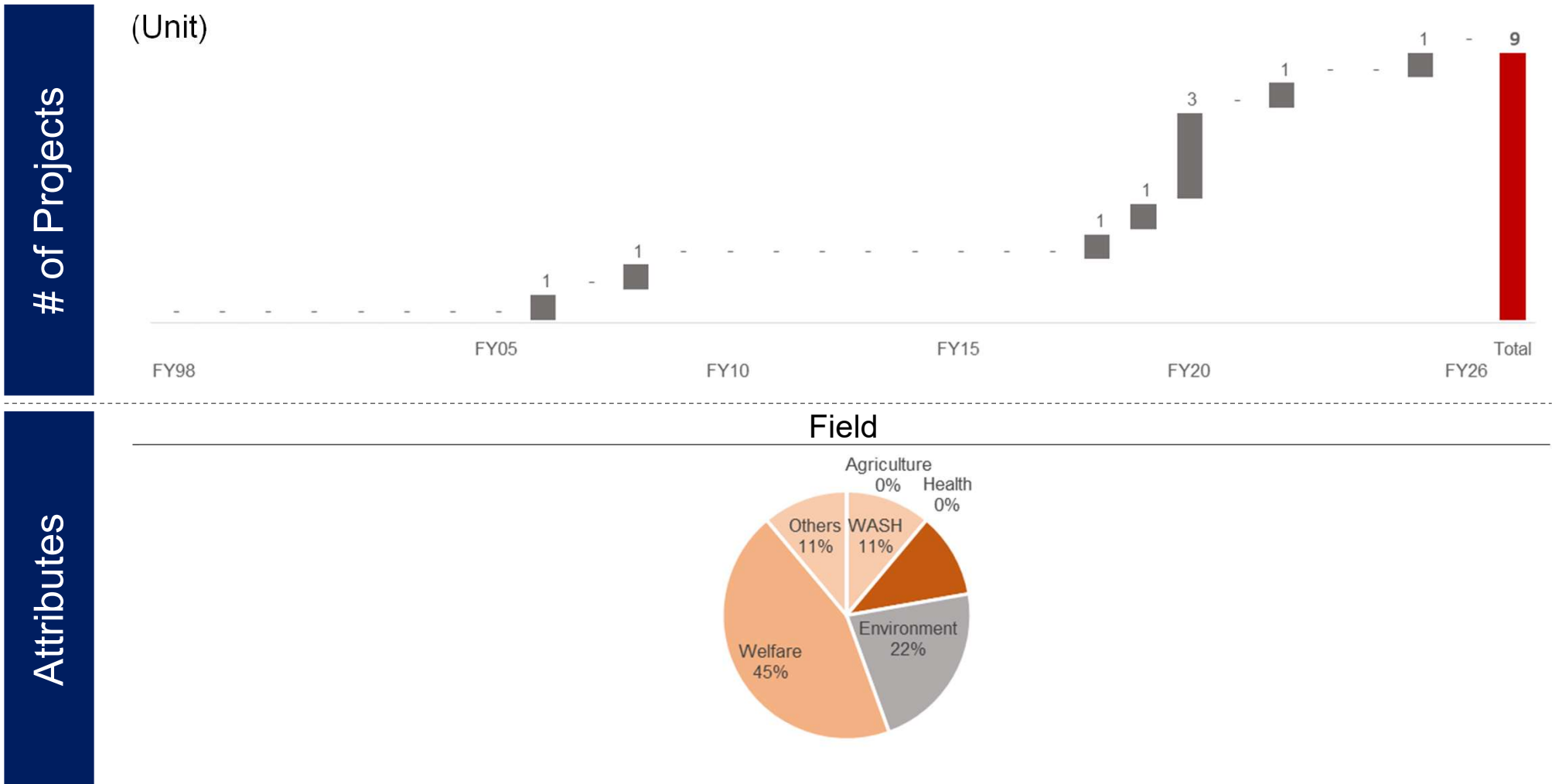

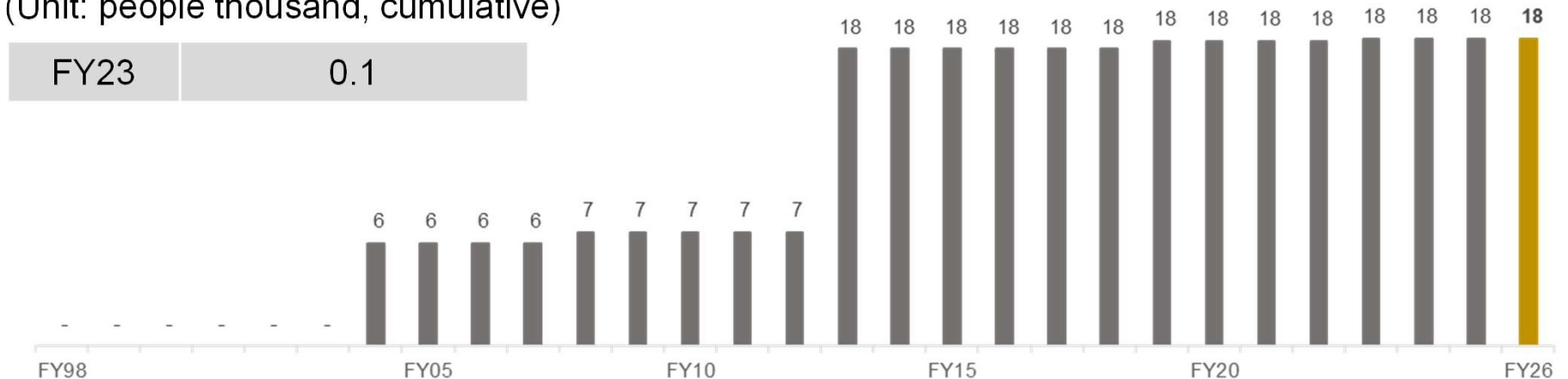

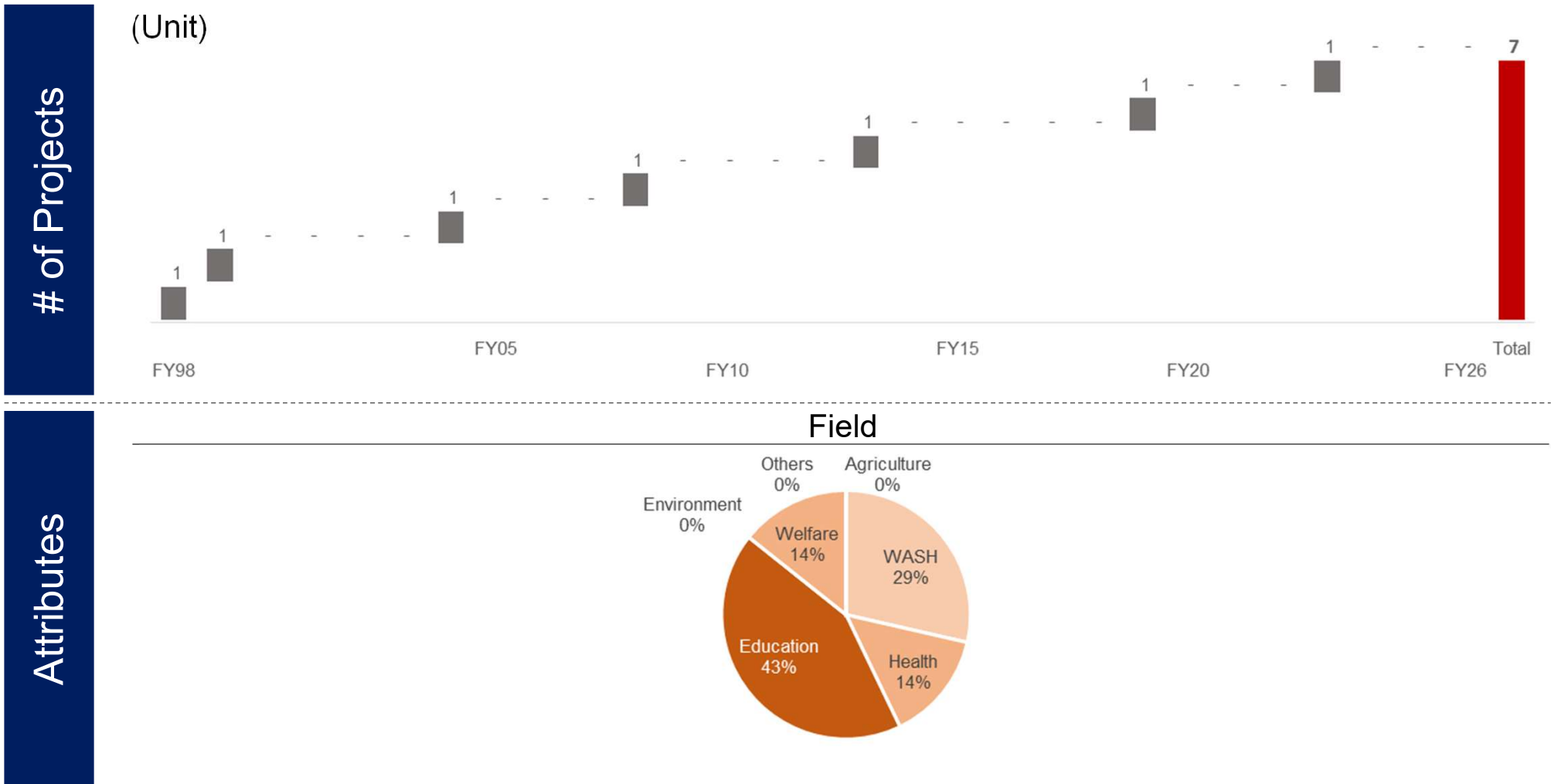

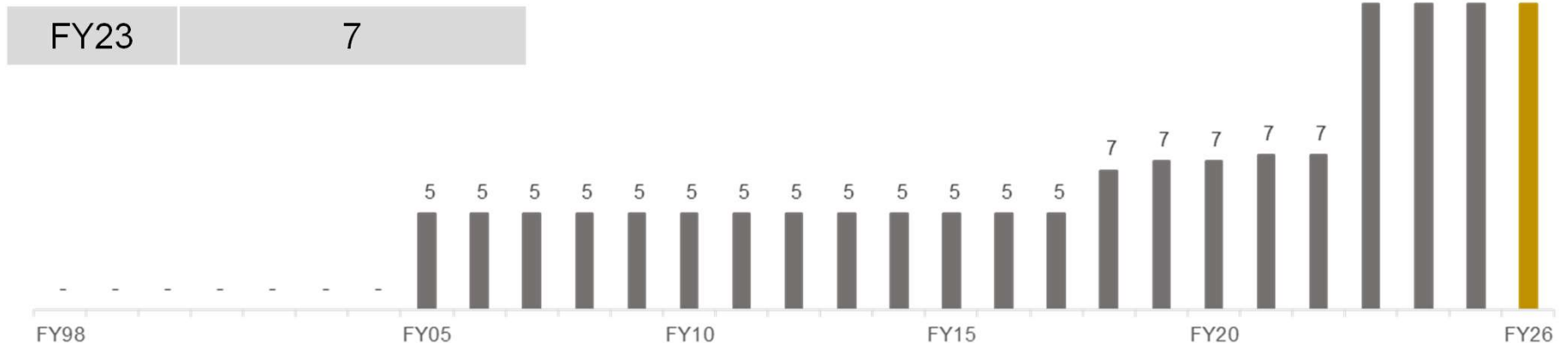

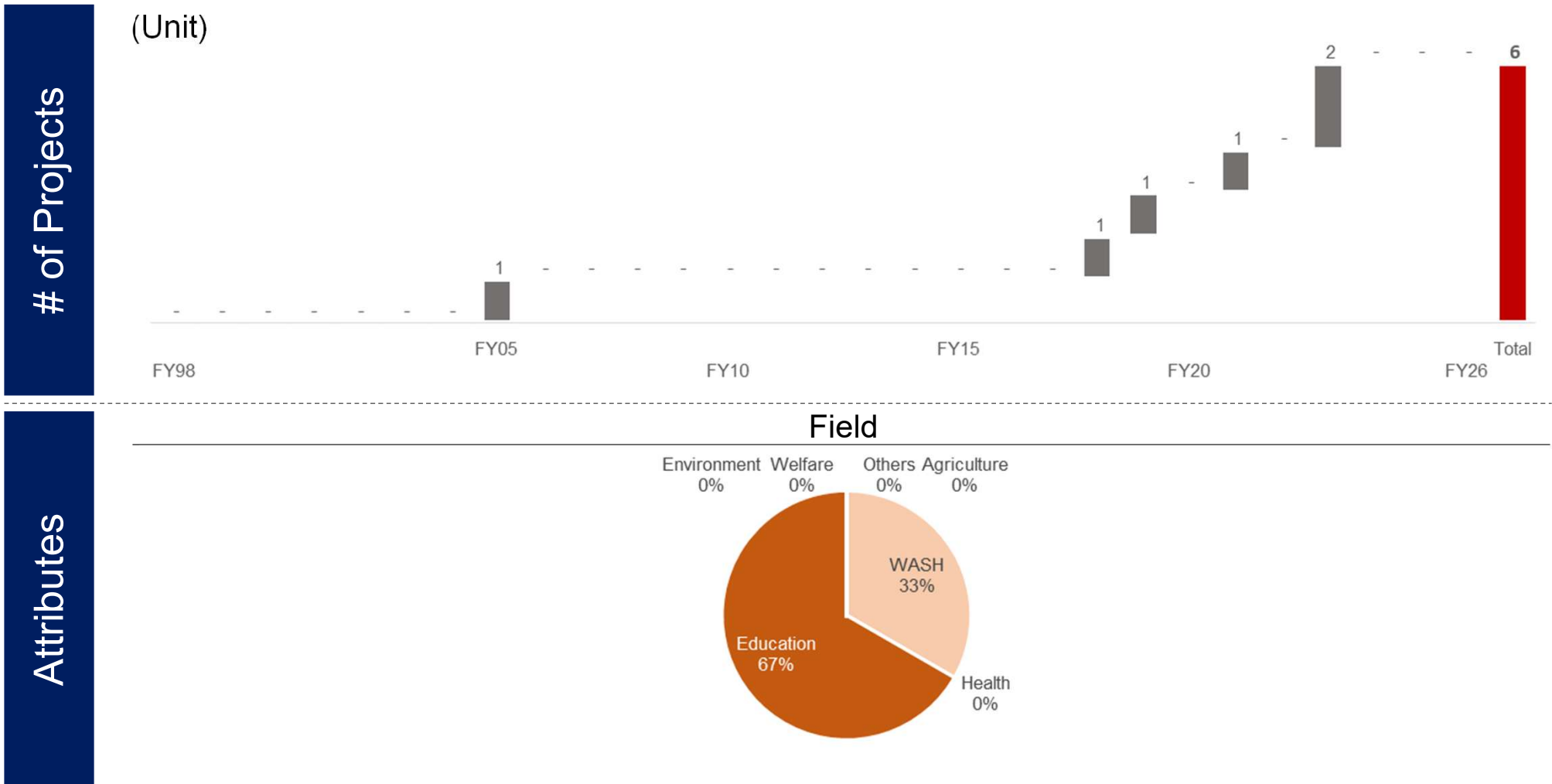

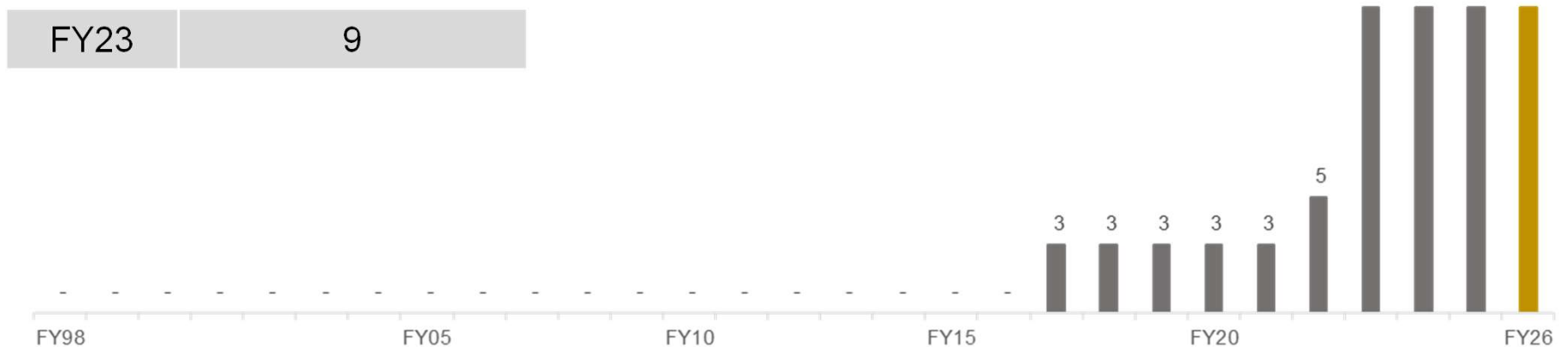

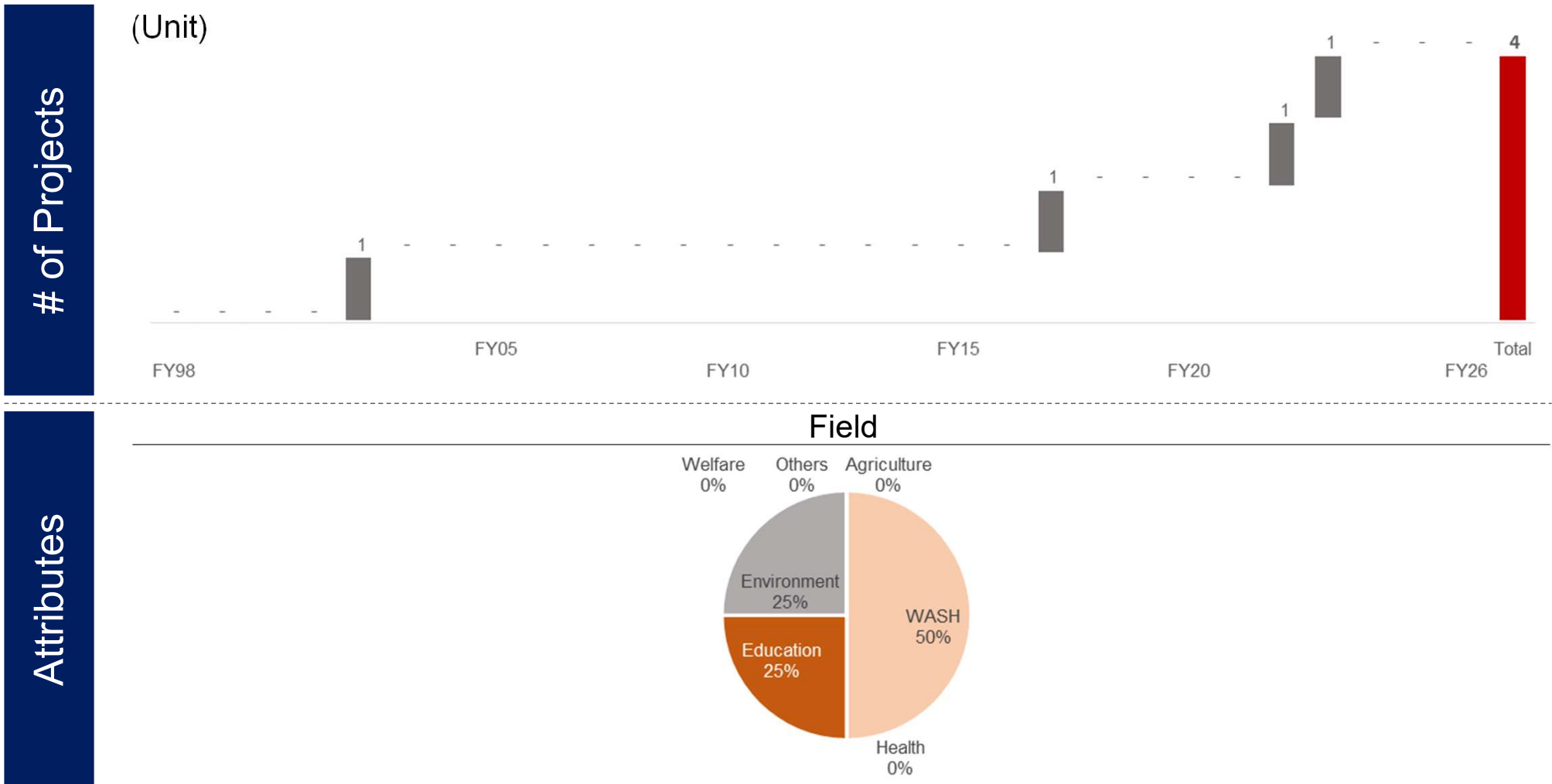
